



## 222 CZERWENKA FOUNDATION APARTMENT

The former apartment of opera singer Oskar Czerwenka (1924–2000), located in the center of Vienna, was renovated and adapted for the rental market. The presence of a central body of sculptural forms gives personality to the home. The aim of this structure, which also houses the storage space, was to welcome residents and visitors and connect the living room with the kitchen and dining area, as well as improve the lighting. Also, its shape provides privacy to the bathroom and bedroom.







Floor plan


The shape of the sculptural module is original and gives the interior a strong personality despite the austerity that has been used to choose colors and materials.

Lighting must be carefully planned in small spaces for functionality and aesthetics. Part of the lighting has been installed in the module, recessed into some of its gaps, which accentuates the theatrical aspect of the structure.
